

# PRESTONWOOD FOREST POOL 2 - POOL RULES

## SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK - NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY

**\*\*Refer to posted schedule for accessible days and hours\*\***

Prestonwood Forest residents are allowed to use Pool-2 without a lifeguard during stated Swim-At-Your-Own-Risk hours. Please note: an adult member (18 years of age or older) MUST be present with children (17 years of age and younger) and no more than four (4) children to every one (1) adult for safety reasons - NO EXCEPTIONS.

A Current and ACTIVE Prestonwood Forest Recreation Access Card IS REQUIRED to enter and use the Pool Facilities. Improper Entry without a Current and ACTIVE Prestonwood Forest Recreation Access Card is considered TRESPASSING. Each 'Access Card' will enable entry of up to NO MORE THAN four (4) persons to enter the pool facility, subject to the maximum safe capacity of the pool.

Anyone violating any of the posted rules will have their access card(s) deactivated and will be suspended from the pool for the remainder of the season. Should damages occur, costs for replacement/repairs will be assessed to the person(s) committing the damages. Facility may ONLY be accessed during posted hours.

1. USE POOL AT YOUR OWN RISK. NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY! The Association is not responsible for accidents or injuries cause by disregard of safety rules or trespassing outside of posted pool hours.
2. Four (4) guests per household allowed and must be accompanied by resident at all times.
3. Prior to leaving the facility, each person is responsible for cleaning up and removing any food trash or soiled diapers, removing all personal belongings and returning pool furniture to a neat position. Please ensure all other trash is disposed of in receptacles provided.
4. Use facility shower to rinse off before and after being in pool water.
5. Proper swim attire only - no cut offs, jogging shorts, revealing swim wear or dyed/printed t-shirts.
6. Children who are not potty-trained must wear a swim diaper AND rubber pants. The child must wear a tight-fitting bathing suit over the diaper. Management must be called immediately if a fecal "accident" occurs, and the pool must then be shut down for a period of 24 hours for treatment.
7. No glass containers allowed.
8. No alcoholic beverages and no smoking allowed in pool facility.
9. No food, paper, gum in the pool water at any time.
10. No bicycles, skateboards, skates or scooters allowed in pool facility or on entry walkways. Only infant strollers and special needs equipment allowed inside pool facility but must be properly secured at a safe distance from the pool edge at all times.
11. No running, pushing or hazardous horseplay at any time.
12. Dive from designated areas only.
13. Be considerate - no yelling, no loud music, no vulgar language or lewd acts.
14. No animals inside the pool facility, with the exception of trained, certified service/assistance animals who are properly restrained. No animals allowed in the pool water at any time.
15. No large pool floats are allowed to deter safety issues.
16. The lifeguard stand is for lifeguard use only and is off-limits 24/7 to all pool members. No climbing on or jumping off lifeguard stand!
17. No playing or removal of safety equipment or life buoys at any time.
18. No throwing of any objects in or around the pool.
19. You must keep your access card in a safe place, and you may not share it with non-pool members. Do not open the pool gates for anyone who does not have an active pool access card with them.
20. **IN THE EVENT OF INCLEMENT WEATHER (THUNDER AND LIGHTNING) ALL PERSONS MUST EXIT THE POOL FACILITY IMMEDIATELY AS A SAFETY PRECAUTION AND MAY NOT RE-ENTER UNTIL INCLEMENT WEATHER PASSES.**
21. Facility is monitored by video surveillance.
22. Please make sure to locate the 911 emergency phone upon entry to avoid any delays in an emergency situation.
